TRADES BURSARY

The Rotary Club of Regina Eastview is giving away a \$500 bursary.

1. This \$500 bursary will be awarded to an Indigenous student entering an apprenticeship trade. The student selected will be entering an apprenticeship program offered either through SIIT (Saskatchewan Indian Institute of Technology) or Saskatchewan Polytechnic.

The bursaries will be paid out for tuition or tools. The tools portion will be paid upon receipt evidence (a sales receipt for the tools and a picture of the student with the tools). The tuition portion will be paid upon evidence of the student's acceptance into the apprenticeship training at the learning institution.

2. This bursary is not necessarily a 'scholarly' one. The club is looking for recipients who are eager to make a difference in the world, to contribute through gainful well paid employment to society and to take the educational opportunity offered them with full commitment and sincerity.

3. **ELIGIBILITY:** The bursary is open to:

- Any Aboriginal student eligible for entering an accredited post-secondary apprenticeship program. (The program must be accredited as a valid program by the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission).
- Children of Rotarians may be eligible for this bursary provided no Rotarians sit on the committee which oversees the evaluation and award of the bursaries.

4. **REPORTING:** . The tuition portion of the bursary will not be paid directly to the student, but rather, a letter will be provided to the student on club stationery and addressed to the post-secondary institution of his/her choice. The letter will inform the post-secondary institution that the Rotary Club of Regina Eastview has awarded this student a scholarship of the stated amount and request a receipt to be mailed to the club for payment.
